Quality assurance

Hair removal with the Soprano ICE laser is the best and **safest** option to permanently get rid of your unwanted hair growth. An affordable solution for all skin and hair types.

Our laser has an **FDA quality mark** and the **CE mark** according to the European Directive 93/42.

The FDA is an American agency that approves medical devices. A quality mark shows that the laser is safe to use and does not cause burns or other damage to the skin. Our laser has therefore been proven to be safe and is also classified as a **class 4 medical laser**. The laser may therefore also be used in hospitals.

In addition, we have our laser maintained and checked annually to ensure that our laser is optimally safe and effective.

What is laser hair removal?

Laser hair removal is a cosmetic treatment that uses a laser device to send light beams to the hair follicles with the aim of destroying the hair follicles. The laser focuses on the pigment in the hair. The light rays convert into heat and when the hair follicle is heated sufficiently, the hair follicle is destroyed, making hair growth from the destroyed hair follicle no longer possible. Permanent hair removal is the result.

Preparation & Aftercare Laser hair removal

- Stop waxing, plucking and using depilatory cream at least 6 weeks before the start of the first treatment and during the treatment process.
- Shave the area to be treated the morning of the treatment.
- Make sure your skin is clean on the day of the treatment.
- Do not use cosmetic products such as body milk, deodorant, foundation, etc. on the area to be treated on the day of the treatment.
- Preferably wear white or light-colored underwear
- If the treated skin is exposed to the sun, we recommend applying at least SPF 30 after the treatment.
- Stop using tanning products.
- Do not expose your skin to the sun for an extended amount of time for 10 days before and after the treatment and avoid the tan lounge during that period.

Contraindications

Laser hair removal treatment is not recommended in the following cases:

Pregnancy Breastfeeding Epilepsy Fever Pacemaker HIV/AIDS Vitiligo Inflammations or infections
Hypersensitivity to light
Anti-inflammatories
Metal prostheses
Autoimmune diseases
Piercings or an implant
Fillers and/or Botox


Use of medications:

- that make your skin sensitive to light (roaccutane, isotretoin/vitamin A cream, antidepressants, St. John's wort, antibiotics or penicillin);
- as anticoagulants (lithium, steroids or Vitamin A acid (such as roaccutane));
- tetracycline, anticoagulants, cytostatics, psoralens.

Tattoos and/or permanent make-up (treatment is possible, we will tape this off).

Cancer, tumors and leukemia (chemotherapy and radiation).

Good to know

- Treatments are carried out at intervals of 4 to 6 weeks for the face and 6 to 8 weeks for the body.
- On average, 6 to 8 treatments are needed.
- Pigmentless hair cannot be treated effectively.
- A reduction of 75-95% of the existing hair is realistic for dark hair.
- 2% of the people are resistant to laser treatment.

During the treatment you wear protective glasses to prevent damage to your eyes. For that reason, we do not allow other people in the treatment room during the treatment. Take this into account if you have younger children, for example.
